

Greeting Message from the President of the Congress

We will hold the 61st annual Congress of The Japan Society of Acupuncture and Moxibustion during the 3 days of 8 June 2012 to 10 June 2012 at Yokkaichi Municipal Hall in Yokkaichi city, Mie prefecture. I think it is an ambitious endeavor to seek the way of coordination and cooperation between

a medical university which provides the leading western medicine and the acupuncture & moxibustion medicine with the original standing position “for patients” as our common medical purpose.
